### Introduction

Nowadays the majority of Adult Education Institutions focus their attention on teaching contents and on trainers' competences. The aim of the Health Tutor project is to place greater attention on the possibility that a healthy environment increases the students' performance and leads them to better job prospects. On this basis, the project proposes the introduction of a Health Tutor into every Adult Education Institution. The mission of the Health Tutor would be to increase the health status of both and students and staff, improving the environment in which they work.

### General information about the project

The Health Tutor project has been financed by the European Commission in the framework of the European Socrates Grundtvig Programme.

The project is coordinated by DAA (German Employee Academy) in cooperation with partners from England, Finland, France, Italy and Poland.


### The second International Meeting

After the kick-off meeting, that took place in Berlin (DE) on the 3rd – 4th of November 2006 the partners met again in Iisalmi (FI) on the 2nd – 3rd of February 2007. During the second meeting the partners discussed the results of the needs analysis of health requirements made by each partner in his own country on students and management. The surveys suggest that there is a great deal of room for improvement in both students' wellbeing and the conditions under which they study. For example the majority of students do not think about their health in college or during their studies.
